  3. ANSWERS must be brief and where ever required answers must be substantiated with relevant Case Laws / Statutory Provision.

*Answer any TWO Topics/ Questions from each of the papers. Each Topic carries 7½ Marks.*

**Paper 7: Legal Regulation of Economic Enterprises**

1. What is a depository? Explain the benefits of Trading and settlement under global depositors.
2. Discuss the scope of legal remedies available for environmental degradation caused by mass disaster in India.
3. Explain the legal regulation of multinationals in India.

**Paper 8: Law of Export, Import Regulation**

1. Explain the process of conservation of Foreign Exchange in India.
2. What are the objects and functions of Export Promotion Councils and critically examine “Automatic route”.
3. Explain the transfer of technology and anti-dumping regulations under W.T.O. discuss with the example of the case laws.

**Paper 9: Banking Law**

1. Analyse the functions of Reserve Banking of India and its role in the development, control and functioning of Banks.
2. Discuss the historical evolution and nationalisation of Banks in India.
3. What are the essential features of negotiable instruments? Distinguish between Transfer and Negotiation.

**Paper 10: Insurance Law**

1. Discuss the importance of ‘Insurable interest’ in life insurance contracts. Whether ‘terrorism’ can be brought under the insurance coverage?
2. State the classification of Marine insurance and briefly explain the various types of marine policies that are available in the market.

3. Discuss the importance of various policies that are available in India for insuring different kinds of properties.

### **Paper 11: Corporate Finance**

1. Define Corporate Finance and explain its objectives and importance from the view point of the Firm, Stakeholders and the Society.
2. Discuss the nature and issue of debentures and explain the kinds of debentures.
3. Explain the administrative regulations of Corporate finance.

### **Paper 12: Environmental and Development Policy and Law**

1. Make a brief note on National Forest Policy – 1952.
2. What is sustainable development? Examine the approach with respect to international Law.
3. Critically examine the enforcement of right to environment.

### **Paper 13: Dissertation**

There are no Internal Assignments for Paper 13. Candidates are to submit **One Dissertation** which carries **80 Marks** for the Project work and **20 Marks** for Viva-Voce on the topic, which they choose.

#### **Instructions:**

1. Students can choose any topic for the Dissertation work from the LL.M. Syllabus.
2. The Dissertation work can be either Doctrinal or Non-Doctrinal mode.
3. The Dissertation must be original contribution of the Candidate and must comply with all the requirements. (Introduction, Hypothesis, Methodology, Citation, Foot note or Chapter notes, Bibliography)
4. Get assistance or advice from Sr. Advocate or Professors locally and attach a Certification with the Dissertation work.
5. Viva-Voce will be conducted after receipt of the Dissertation work. Date and Time of Viva-Voce will be intimated by separate communication.
6. Printed and bound copy of the Dissertation work must reach ***“The Director, Directorate of Distance Education, Kuvempu University, Shankaraghatta – 577 451”***, on or before ***31<sup>st</sup> JULY 2010*** ***Dissertation received after due date will not be considered for Valuation.***
