TOPICS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT ASSIGNMENTS (2009-10)

1. Students are advised to read the separate enclosed instructions, before beginning the writing Assignments.
 2. Out of 20 Internal Assignment marks per paper, 5 marks will be awarded for regularity (attendance) to Counseling/Contact Programme Classes pertaining to the paper. Therefore, the topics given below are only for 15 marks each paper.
 3. ANSWERS must be brief and where ever required answers must be substantiated with relevant Case Laws / Statutory Provision.

Answer any TWO Topics/ Questions from each of the papers. Each Topic carries 7½ Marks.

Paper1: Law and Social Transformation in India

1. Discuss the concept of 'Right to Education' under the constitutional provisions. Critically examine the recent notification with respect to Right to Education.
2. How language can be treated as the divisive factor.
3. Explain the various measures to be taken to protect the interest of women and children.

Paper 2: Indian Constitution: The New Challenges

1. Explain the Right of Minorities to establish and administer educational institutions.
2. Discuss the development of Electoral reforms and provisions of constitution of Election Commission under Indian Constitution.
3. How public interest litigations are widening the scope of Article-21 of Indian Constitution.

Paper 3: Judicial Process

1. Explain the concept of various theories of Justice in the Western thought.
2. Examine the contemporary dimensions of Judicial activism and Structural challenges.
3. Critically examine the concept of "Dharma" different from and compare the same with term Justice.

Paper 4: Legal Education and Research Methodology

1. Discuss the objectives of Legal education and imparting legal education with assisting modern technology.
2. What is Hypothesis? Explain research design with respect to Hypothesis, with an example.

3. Write short Notes on:
 1. Problem solving method.
 2. Tabulation

Paper 5: Doctrinal and Non-Doctrinal Research (Practical)

There is no Internal Assignment for Paper-05. Candidates are to prepare Two Dissertations one on Doctrinal and another on Non-Doctrinal mode respectively. Students are expected to follow the guidance given in the study guide lines on Paper V.

Students may select any relevant topic for the preparation of the Dissertation. The rationale behind this part of the course is to sharpen the Written, Communication skills and also to channelise their thought process.

The Non-Doctrinal work may be Comprehensive case study/Emperical study/ Field study.

1. The student may choose any Topic of his/her choice relevant to the Syllabus for the purpose of the study. (Refer Chapter II of Practical Paper)

The Dissertations must be in the following form :

The information collected has to be presented in an organised and structural way. The design of the dissertation shall consist of

1. Introduction
2. Objectives of the Study
3. Hypothesis
4. Methodology
5. Limitations
6. Core-Chapter-Evaluation
7. Findings and suggestion
8. Bibliography

Footnotes or Chapter notes is a must.

The subject matter organised as above has to be neatly typed or computerised and submitted in the hard bound form along with respective CDs. The ideal size of the Dissertation may be in the range of 50 to 60 Pages.

Submission of the Dissertation :

One copy of each Dissertation (Doctrinal and Non-Doctrinal work) shall be submitted to *“The Director, Directorate of Distance Education, Kuvempu University, Shankaraghatta – 577 451”, on or before 31st JULY 2010 Dissertation received after due Date will not be considered for Valuation.*
